

## **Town of Platteville Monthly Board Meeting Minutes**

### **Town Board Meeting**

The meeting was called to order by Tom Weigel at 6:00 P.M.

Members present: Aaron Digman, Tom Weigel, Dave Klar, Nathan Niehaus, and Chad Droessler.

The agenda was reviewed. Motion by Digman to approve the agenda as presented, seconded by Droessler. Motion carried.

The minutes of the January meeting were reviewed. Motion by Droessler to approve the minutes as presented for the Monthly Meeting, seconded by Digman.

Klar presented the treasurer's report. Total account balances as of February 1<sup>st</sup> were \$1,433,415.62. Motion by Droessler to approve the treasurer's report, seconded by Digman. Motion carried.

The bills for the month were reviewed, totaling \$1,020,790.89. Motion by Digman to approve the bills as presented, seconded by Droessler. Motion carried.

The Major Lane turnaround was discussed considering the 2 proposals presented by Delta 3 at the January meeting. The property owners at the end of the current road want a turnaround but don't want the road to end at the turnaround. Weigel is going to talk with Delta 3 about possible options.

Kurt stated that he has been working on the equipment, people are hitting deer in Brown Deer, stated that Southwest road is getting more dangerous with number of vehicles trying to get onto HWY 151 as well as large backups for people trying to get off of HWY 151, garbage is still being thrown out on Stumptown and Southwest, and he and Tom are going to look at areas that need trees cut back.

No new driveway or building permits.

Rocky Skemp asked the board what the plans were for the old truck, it will be put up for sale when the new truck is put into service and stated that people are still throwing recycling trash into his fields when the city recycling center is closed.

The board placed the checks in envelopes for the bills to be paid.
