### **Town Board Meeting**

The meeting was called to order by Tom Weigel at 6:00 P.M.

Weigel stated that they had to order new tires at \$400/tire from Dewey as there was a blowout with one of them today.

Bidding was discussed for a new  $\frac{3}{4}$  ton truck. Kurt is going to talk with all the dealers in town and have them put together a bid to replace the current truck.

Kurt stated that people have been dumping tree debris on Stumptown and Southwest Road when the gates for the city recycling center have been closed. People have been tailgating him as he is trying to plow the roads.

The board placed the checks in envelopes for the bills to be paid.
