

Town of Platteville Monthly Board Meeting Minutes

Monday June 8th, 2026

Town Board Meeting

The meeting was called to order by Tom Weigel at 6:00 P.M.

Members present: Chad Droessler, Tom Weigel, Dave Klar, and Nathan Niehaus. Absent: Aaron Digman.

The clerk verified that the open meeting law was met. Notice was posted in 3 locations and the website. WWW.TOWNOFPLATTEVILLE.COM

The agenda was reviewed. Motion by Droessler to approve the agenda as presented, seconded by Weigel. Motion carried.

The minutes of the May meeting were reviewed. Motion by Droessler to approve the minutes as presented, seconded by Weigel. Motion carried.

Klar presented the treasurer's report. Total account balances as of June 1st were \$439,058.48. Motion by Droessler to approve the treasurer's report, seconded by Weigel. Motion carried.

The bills for the month were reviewed totaling \$9,387.55. Motion by Weigel to approve the bills as presented, seconded by Droessler. Motion carried.

Kurt stated that he had Matt Brunton help him fix a part of the fence at the Cemetery, he has been mowing and patching as well, and that 300 tons of wedging has been completed. Weigel stated that Digman Construction has offered to purchase the old truck in the amount of \$12,750.00. Motion by Droessler to approve the sale of the 2016 Ford Pickup to Diman Construction, seconded by Weigel. Motion carried.

Nate Fosbinder stated that some of the roads need some shoulder work done and asked if it would be beneficial to use the grader for that. Weigel stated that the town purchased a blade for the back of the tractor for this purpose. Isaac Shanley stated that George Lazarus's plan was tabled at the county zoning meeting even with no residents in attendance opposing the project. Keith Lane, zoning administrator for Grant County, was present and stated that he has new county board members on the committee, and they are asking more questions about projects that what the previous committee did.

The board placed the checks in envelopes for the bills to be paid.

The next meeting will be Monday July 13th.

Motion by Weigel to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Droessler. Motion carried. Meeting was adjourned at 6:40 P.M.
