

Town of Platteville Monthly Board Meeting Minutes

Monday March 10th, 2025

Town Board Meeting

The meeting was called to order by Tom Weigel at 6:24 P.M. following the plan commission meeting.

Members present: Chad Droessler, Dan Smith, Tom Weigel, Dave Klar, and Nathan Niehaus.

The clerk verified that the open meeting law was met. Notice was posted in 3 locations and the website. WWW.TOWNOFPLATTEVILLE.COM

The agenda was reviewed. Motion by Droessler to approve the agenda as presented, seconded by Smith. Motion carried.

The minutes from the February meeting were reviewed. Motion by Smith to approve the minutes as presented, seconded by Droessler. Motion carried.

Klar presented the treasurer's report. Total account balances as of March 1st were \$515,603.64. Klar stated that the equipment CD was transferred into the money market account. Motion by Droessler to approve the treasurer's report, seconded by Smith. Motion carried.

The bills for the month were reviewed totaling \$7,651.76. Motion by Smith to approve the bills as presented, seconded by Droessler. Motion carried.

The Grant County Real Estate Services land division and rezone request was discussed. Members were disturbed that no one was present to answer questions. Motion by Smith to approve the land division and rezone request for 4.09 acres from FP Zoning to A2 Zoning, seconded by Droessler. Motion carried.

Kurt stated that a college student has been parking a camper and truck on the cul-de-sacs on College Farm and Cheese Factory, he has talked with the Sherriff's office, and they stated according to statute he is parked legally. There was a discussion about drafting an ordinance regarding parking on town roads. He stated that the path on Second road will get swept soon, that the white truck needs tires, and Dreamr court has been tore up.

No new driveway or building permits.

Weigel stated that there are several concerns arising with chicken barns and setbacks throughout the township. Some discussion about drafting an ordinance for small chicken coops.

Nate Fosbinder stated that someone in his neighborhood is building a shed.

The board placed the checks in envelopes for the bills to be paid.

Motion by Droessler to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Smith. Motion carried. Meeting was adjourned at 6:58 P.M.
