

Town of Platteville Monthly Board Meeting Minutes

Tuesday January 13th, 2026

Town Board Meeting

The meeting was called to order by Tom Weigel at 6:00 P.M.

Members present: Aaron Digman, Tom Weigel, Dave Klar, Nathan Niehaus, and Chad Droessler.

The clerk verified that the open meeting law was met. Notice was posted in 3 locations, and the website. WWW.TOWNOFPLATTEVILLE.COM

The agenda was reviewed. Motion by Digman to approve the agenda as presented, seconded by Droessler. Motion carried.

The minutes of the December meetings were reviewed. Motion by Droessler to approve the minutes as presented for the Monthly Meeting, seconded by Digman. Motion carried. Motion by Digman to approve the minutes as presented for the Special Meeting, seconded by Droessler. Motion carried.

Klar presented the treasurer's report. Total account balances as of January 1st were \$937,934.36. Motion by Digman to approve the treasurer's report, seconded by Droessler. Motion carried.

The bills for the month were reviewed, totaling \$586,294.18. Motion by Droessler to approve the bills as presented, seconded by Digman. Motion carried.

Mark Digman from Delta 3 Engineering presented 2 possible options for a cul-de-sac turnaround on Major Lane. Option 1 would be a tear drop utilizing property from both sides of the road, while option 2 would be a P design utilizing property on the East side of Major Lane. Landowners on all sides were present and participated in the discussion with the board. This will be on the agenda in February for more discussion.

Quotes were looked at for the purchase of a new pickup truck. Kurt obtained quotes from all 3 dealerships Kunes, Runde, and Pioneer Ford for a replacement truck like is currently in operation. Kunes \$54,294.00, Runde \$53,715.00 for a 2500 and \$53,557.00 for a 3500, and Pioneer Ford \$49,627.00. After discussion motion by Droessler to purchase a 2026 Ford from Pioneer Ford to replace the current pickup, seconded by Digman. Motion carried.

Kurt stated that the plow trucks have had some maintenance getting done on them, has been cutting trees, and picking up brush.

No new driveway or building permits.

Digman addressed concern about the excessive amount of gravel in yards on the roads that J&N seal coated and stated that he had a call about loan assistance.

Toni Izzard presented information about property fraud and offered suggestions for the town. Niehaus will investigate this.

Carol Ann Hood asked if the treasurer should be available at the town hall for more hours for tax collections.

The board placed the checks in envelopes for the bills to be paid.

The next meeting will be on Monday February 9th at 6:00.

Motion by Droessler to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Digman. Motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 7:39 P.M.
